INTRODUCTION

The Mathematics for Sustainable Development (MATH4SDG) project, funded by NORAD under the NORHED II programme, in collaboration with CoRE-MATH, ISP and Sida, is organising the 2nd African-Nordic Conference in Mathematics. The conference, which will take place at Arusha, Tanzania, is being organised through the three MATH4SDG partner institutions at the University of Dar es Salaam (the host), Makerere University (Uganda) and University of Bergen (Norway)

The goal of the conference is to bring together researchers in mathematics and mathematics education to share knowledge, skills, current developments in the fields and promote research collaboration among researchers from Eastern Africa region, the rest of Africa, Europe, Asia, Australia and America.

CONFERENCE PARTICIPATION

The Conference audience will be mathematicians from the Eastern Africa region, the rest of Africa, Europe and the rest of the world. It is anticipated that the total number of conference participants will be about 150.

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Abstracts (not more than 400 words) must be prepared and uploaded either in LaTeX or Word using the templates provided on the tabs on the right side of the conference page. Submissions should be sent via the online submission portal. The deadline for abstract submissions is 31st May 2026.

CONFERENCE SPECIAL ISSUE

The 2nd African-Nordic conference organisers are working with the editor of the Tanzania Journal of Science (TJS) to publish selected, peer-reviewed papers from the conference, as part of a dedicated Special issue of the journal. Arusha city offers a variety of accommodation options, and the Local Organizing Committee (LOC) has negotiated special discounted Bed and breakfast rates with the following hotels:

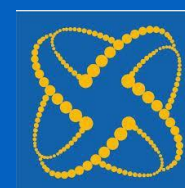
