INTRODUCTION

The Mathematics for Sustainable Development (MATH4SDG) project, funded by NORAD under the NORHED II programme, in collaboration with CoRE-MATH, ISP and Sida, is organising the 2nd African-Nordic Conference in Mathematics. The conference, which will take place at Arusha, Tanzania, is being organised through the three MATH4SDG partner institutions at the University of Dar es Salaam (the host), Makerere University (Uganda) and University of Bergen (Norway).

The goal of the conference is to bring together researchers in mathematics and mathematics education to share knowledge, skills, current developments in the fields and promote research collaboration among researchers from Eastern Africa region, the rest of Africa, Europe, Asia, Australia and America.

CONFERENCE PARTICIPATION

The Conference audience will be mathematicians from the Eastern Africa region, the rest of Africa, Europe and the rest of the world. It is anticipated that the total number of conference participants will be about 150.

CONFERENCE SPECIAL ISSUE

The 2nd African-Nordic conference organisers are working with the editor of the Tanzania Journal of Science (TJS) to publish selected, peer-reviewed papers from the conference, as part of a dedicated Special issue of the journal.
